## Is the Vienna Card convenient?

It covers all public transports and offers lots of discounts.

Try to count how many times you will take public transports to move and multiply for 2.20 euros (the Cost of a single ticket in 2017).

We found it useful, allowed us to move freely without worrying about spending too much and look for places to buy tickets!

COST: 24 h € 13,90 - 48 h €21,90 - 72 h € 24,90

## Is the Sissi Card convenient?

If you'll visit Hofburg, Imperial Supplies and Schonbrunn the answer is: absolutely yes!! With a single ticket you can skip queues and even save.

COST: Adults 29,90 euro

"Sepp Bitzinger Albertina" in front of the legendary Hotel Sacher
